THE ROLL-UP

WHY?

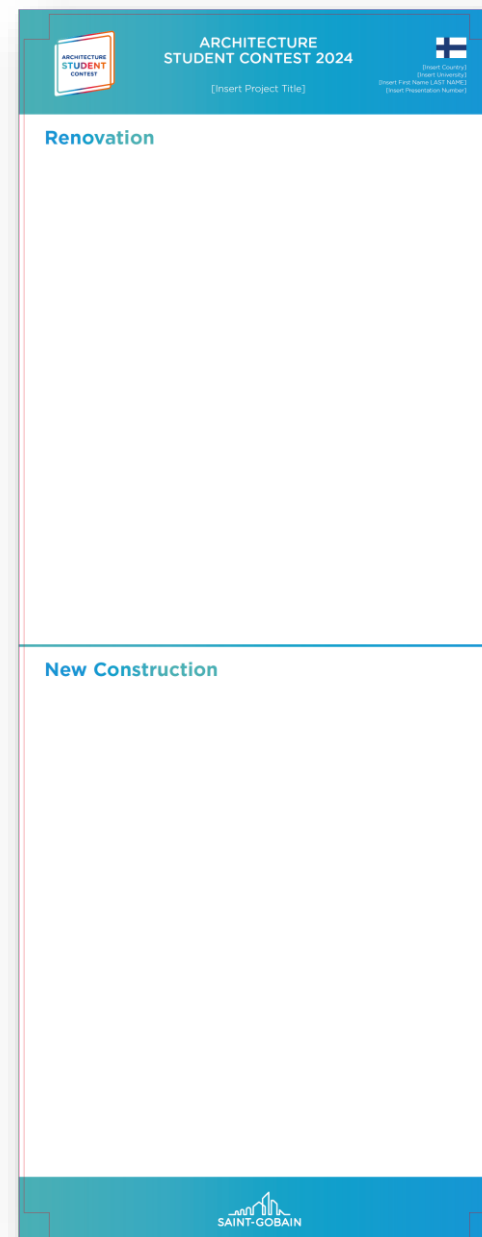
To showcase and share your project with the other participants and Jury members

WHEN?

All the roll-ups will be displayed during the Projects Exhibition of the International Stage on June 10 – 12, 2024

HOW?

All the requirements are on the next page and in the **Rules & Organization Guide** (page 11) available on the [Architecture Student Contest website](#)



REQUIREMENTS

Warning!

Avoid too much information



Your roll-up must respect the following criteria:

- **Dimension:** 70 x 180 cm
- **Minimum line size:** 0.5pt
- **Minimum font size:** 12pt
- **PDF Scale:** 1:1
- **Maximum weight of the document:** 50 Mo
- **Color:** CMYK (Cyan, Magenta, Yellow, Black) using Fogra 39 profile (offset printing)
- **Good quality photos**
- **Avoid color gradients** - *They don't come out very well in print*
- **Don't put anything on the back of the roll-up**
- **Do not overload your roll-up** with text and images - *See example on the right*



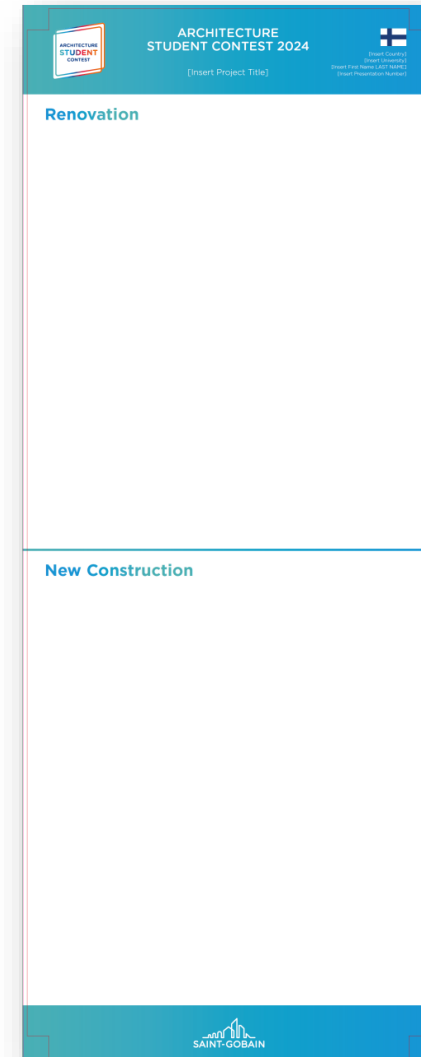
STEPS TO FOLLOW



1. OPEN THE TEMPLATE (AI OR PDF)

2. FILL-IN THE ROLL-UP HEADER

Replace the Finnish flag by your country flag*
Keep the same size



Complete the information and delete the "[]"

The presentation number will be communicated to you by your Saint-Gobain Local Leader

**You must use the country flags that you will find in the "Flags package" available in the International Stage Project Submission e-mail and on the [Architecture Student Contest website](#), in the International Stage section.*

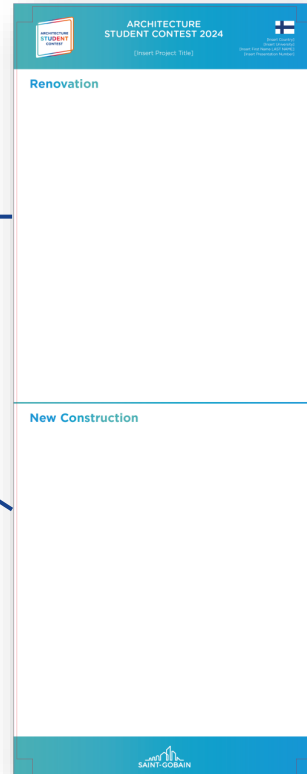
3. FILL IN THE ROLL-UP

Fill in the roll-up template with key elements (visuals, text, graph, etc.).

Insert here the information regarding the **Renovation** of your project

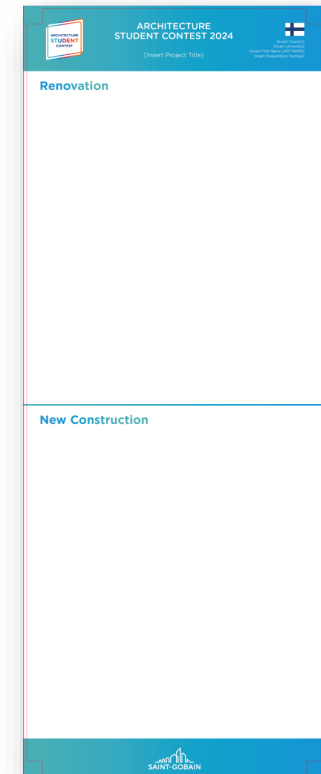
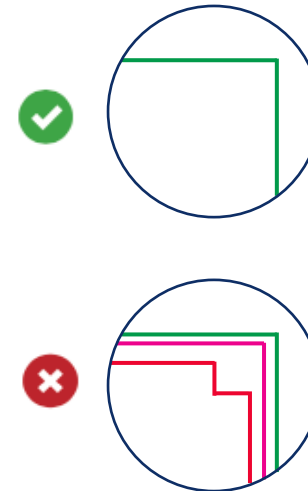
Insert here the information regarding the **New Construction** of your project

IMPORTANT: Renovation and New Construction can be presented together, rather than separated in two sections, if elements from each are clearly identifiable. Keep in mind that both themes are considered in the Judging Criteria, and that this will impact the evaluation of the project.



4. REMOVE THE CONSTRUCTION LINES

Once you have integrated all the elements, remove the construction lines (red and pink lines). **Do not delete the green line.**

5. RENAME AND SAVE THE ROLL-UP

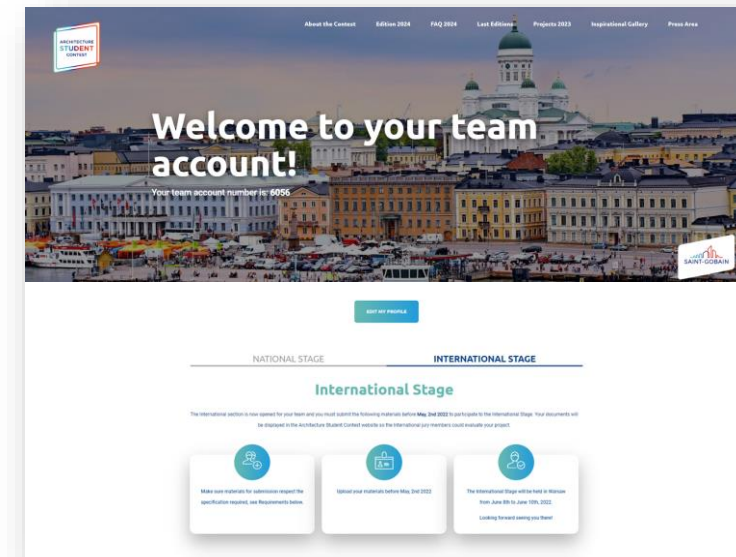

BEWARE OF THE COLOR LINES

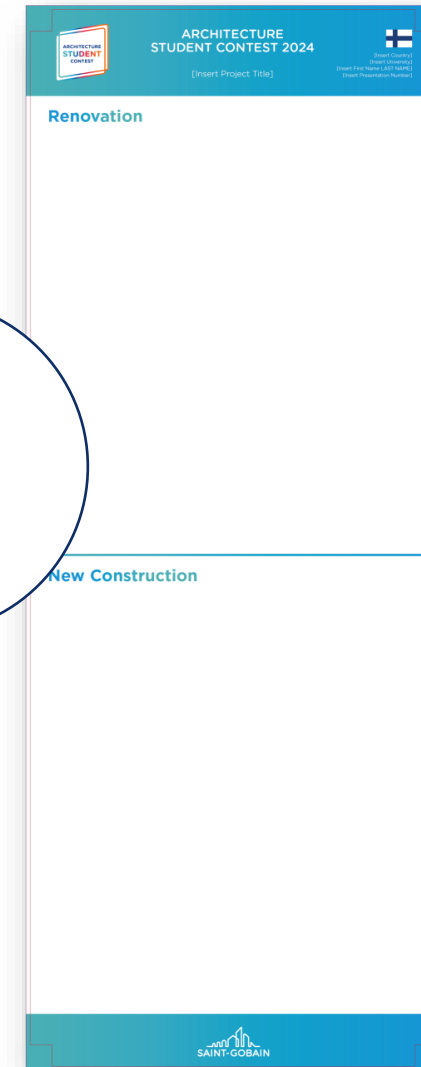
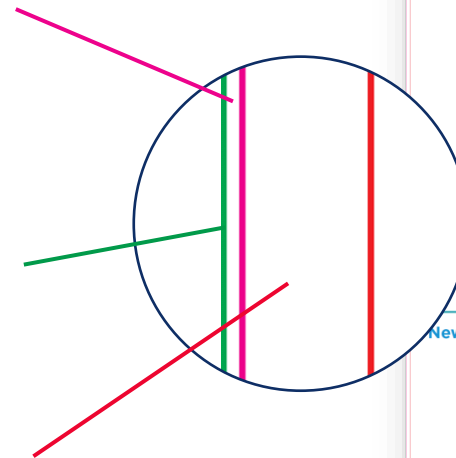


Do not put anything important in the space between the pink and the green line.

For a clean layout, stretch your background (if you have one) up to the green line.

You should not put anything important between the red and the green line.*

** Except a background if you have one.*
